- Tracing paper, pencil, eraser
- Watercolour Paper: you can use leftover piece of 140 lb Hot Press watercolour paper as well as paper cut to 5"x7" size. You should have at least 3 pieces
- McCaffery Brown Or McCaffery Black or Copic Sepia 0.3 Multiliner Pen
- > Pointed Pen with a medium flexible nib
- Two water dishes and kitchen towel
- Small Watercolour brushes with a fine pointed tip : Princeton Round Velvet Touch Sizes 0, 1 and 2 are good choices
- Suggested Watercolours Jewel Tones : Payne's Grey, Indanthrene or Ultramarine Blue, Vermillion, Alizarin Crimson, Sap Green, Hooker's Green
- > Animals / Birds Burnt Umber, Burnt Sienna, Sepia, Yellow Ochre, Cerulean Blue
- If you are new to watercolour, a Daniel Smith Dot card is good option and will give you enough colours to paint your miniature designs
- > Dr. Ph Martin's Bleed proof White for detailing
- > 23k gold leaf with Miniatum Ink and applicator tool such as Size 0 Taper Point Clay Shaper
