RECOMMENDED WORKSHOP SUPPLIES FOR ENGROSSER'S SCRIPT

- > Pen holder is an oblique, but some prefer a straight pen holder. I will be using an oblique pen holder
- Nib, I would like to start with a Nikko G. Not knowing everyone's writing style or how heavy handed one maybe, this nib is stiff and allows one to work toward achieving those thin lines needed in this script and allow to provide a good shaped down stroke. If you are an experienced pointed pen user, then use the nib of your choice.
- Paper, I would suggest using Rhodia blank paper. This way you can copy the guide sheet that I will provide onto the Rhodia blank paper. Rhodia is an excellent paper to write with a pointed pen. Plus, it accepts most inks without bleeding.
- > Ink, I would suggest the Old World ink, any of the McCaffery inks, or an ink that you know and can use with the pointed pen.
